

ANNEX – B: EVACUATION / EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY AREAS

Evacuation

In the event that you need to evacuate from your building as a result of an audible / visual alarm or at the direction

of commands from the campus enunciation system you should:

1. Remain calm, do not rush or panic.
2. Walk to the nearest safe exit and / or stairwell to leave from the first floor.
3. Do not use elevators.
4. Individuals with disabilities may need assistance. If unable to assist, notify authorities of their location immediately.
5. Evacuate to your building’s designated Emergency Assembly Area (see below).
6. DO NOT re-enter the building until further instruction by Campus Safety and Security personnel or other emergency personnel.
7. In the event that you are unable to locate the emergency assembly area, stay a minimum of 150 feet away from the building.
